Training Guideline for COVID-19 Vaccine Administration

The Utah Department of Health, Bureau of EMS and Preparedness established the following criteria for utilization of EMS personnel to administer COVID-19 vaccines. Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) are now authorized to administer COVID-19 vaccine with proper training. These guidelines may be utilized for any organization that is administering the vaccine. EMT

☐ The organization utilizing EMTs to administer vaccines must provide direct training on intermuscular injections with both didactic and hands on training before authorizing an EMT to give vaccines. The below resources are being provided to help with Just-in-Time Training for EMTs.
